NOTE: Obedience entries will be in Jump Height order. On Saturday, December 12, the order will be from high to low. On Sunday, the order will be from low to high. Please be sure to include the jump height on the entry form.

- Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.
- No refunds for duplicate entries. However, care will be taken to find duplicates before processing. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms. Illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show.
